



SQUAMISH SOCCERFEST RULES 2011

HAVE FUN ... AND REMEMBER TO DRINK LOTS OF WATER.

SCORING:

WIN	6 POINTS
SHOOTOUT WIN	3 POINTS
SHOOTOUT LOSS	1 POINT
LOSS	0 POINTS

ROUND ROBIN TIE DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

- WINS vs LOSSES
- HEAD TO HEAD
- BEST GOAL DIFFERENCE
- MOST GOALS FOR
- LEAST GOALS AGAINST
- 3 PENALTY SHOTS

with a 2 GOAL MAX (1 point per goal in regulation time to a max. of 2)

So ... 2 - 0 win would be 8 points, a 1 - 0 win w/be 7 points, a 0 - 0 game w/a S/O win w/be 3 points and a 1 - 1 game w/a S/O WIN w/be 4 points for the winner and 2 points for the losing team.

ALL TEAMS MUST BE WARMED UP AND READY TO START EACH GAME WHEN THE REFEREE IS SET TO START the schedule is tight and with your help we can keep the tournament on schedule.

EACH TEAM MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING FOR EACH GAME:

1 GAME BALL and 1 LINESMAN

***PLAYERS CAN PLAY ON ONE TEAM ONLY* THE ONE HE/SHE IS REGISTERED ON.** ANY PLAYER FOUND PLAYING ON A SECOND TEAM, WILL BE EJECTED FROM THE TOURNAMENT AND THE SECOND TEAM WILL FORFEIT ALL POINTS FOR THAT GAME.

ALL PRIZE WINNING GAMES MUST BE PLAYED OUT, OR EACH TEAM WILL FORFEIT 50% OF THE PRIZE MONEY.

YELLOW CARDS:

A player who receives 2 yellow cards in one game will sit the remainder of that game & the next game. Any player who accumulates 3 yellows will also sit out the following game.

RED CARDS:

Any player who receives a red card will sit out the rest of that game and the next game. He may also receive further game suspensions depending on the severity of the call.

ALL REFEREE CALLS WILL BE FINAL!

LADIES GAMES: 7 A-SIDE

Round robin games: no extra playing time

20 minute halves

F.I.F.A. rules apply—except no off sides

In the event of a tie the game will be decided by 3 penalty shots. Sudden death penalty shots if still tied

Semi final and final games: OPEN DIVISION ONLY 20 minute halves In the event of a tie, 5 minute halves will be played and then 3 penalty shots (if still tied)

Sudden death penalty shots (if still tied)

GOALIES PLAY THE BALL AS PER A REGULAR GAME

(there are no limits as to how far they may kick the ball despite the field sizes)

LADIES OPEN:

There are 2 groups of 6 teams in the division.

Both groups will play a round robin format within their group. Each group plays 4 games drawn from hat. 1st & 2nd in each group will advance to the semi-finals. Winner of each group will play 2nd place of opposite group. *Teams may have an unlimited roster with unlimited subs.*

LADIES OPEN REC

There is one group of 6 teams in the division.

The winner will be the team with the highest points after the round robin play. In the event of a tie we will follow the tie breaking rules set up. *Teams may have an unlimited roster with unlimited subs.*

LADIES OVER 30

There is one group of 6 teams in the division.

The winners will be the team with the highest points after the round robin play. In the event of a tie we will follow the tie breaking rules set up. *Each team may have a maximum of 2 players in their 29th year.* Teams may have an unlimited roster with unlimited subs. **NO SLIDE TACKLING ALLOWED.**

LADIES OVER 30 RECREATION

There is one group of 12 teams in the division.

The winners will be the team with the highest points after the round robin play. In the event of a tie we will follow the tie breaking rules set up. ***No players under the age of 30 allowed to play in this division.***

Teams may have an unlimited roster with unlimited subs. **NO SLIDE TACKLING ALLOWED**

MENS GAMES

Round robin games: no extra playing time

30 minute halves

F.I.F.A. rules apply

In the event of a tie the game will be decided by 3 penalty shots.

Sudden death penalty shots if still tied

Semi final and final games:

30 minute halves

In the event of a tie 5 minute halves will be played -3

penalty shots (if still tied)

-Sudden death penalty shots (if still tied)

MENS OPEN:

There are 2 groups of 4 teams and 2 groups of 3 teams.... Each group plays a round robin format, groups C & D will play one crossover game. The top team in each group will advance to the semi finals. A random draw will determine who plays who. The winners of these games will advance to the finals and play for 1st and 2nd. The losers of these games will play to determine 3rd place. Teams may have an unlimited roster with unlimited subs. *Teams allowed 2 premier players per team.*

MENS OVER 30:

There are 3 groups of 4 teams. Each group plays a round robin format. The top team in each group and 1 team decided by the round robin tie breaker rules will advance to the semi finals. A random draw will determine who plays who. The winners of these will advance to the finals for 1st and 2nd. The losers of these games will play to determine 3rd place. Teams may have an unlimited roster with unlimited subs.

MENS OVER 40:

There is 1 group of 4 and 2 groups of 3 teams. Each group plays a round robin format, groups B & C will play one crossover game. Winner of each group plus the highest second place team of the three groups will advance to the semi-finals. A random draw will determine who plays who. The winners of these will advance to the finals for 1st and 2nd. The losers of these games will play to determine 3rd place. Teams may have an unlimited roster with unlimited subs.

NO SLIDE TACKLING ALLOWED.
